**13.Mannheim, Germany.** *World Day of Philosophy 2021: Public lecture "Responsibility for the Future and Climate Ethics" Public lecture with reception on the World Day of Philosophy with a greeting by Rector Prof. Dr. Thomas Puhl" by Mannheim University. The effects of climate change that are currently being felt are harbingers of the probably much more serious consequences that are to be expected in the next generation and the one after that. But the consequences of the necessary adaptations will also be serious. That there is a moral responsibility to avoid these grave evils is not in dispute. It is unclear, however, who bears this responsibility. One frequently given answer is that climate responsibility falls primarily, or even solely, on states and large, globally active corporations. The latter implies means "to cure or relieve illnesses". However, philosophical consultation does not aim at such an such an objective. Moreover, in some countries, the use of the term "THERAPY" is regulated and often reserved for the medical field. Finally, the term "PHILOTHERAPY" was initially used to draw attention to the fact that attention to the fact that philosophers were now offering consultations and opening specialized practices for this purpose specialized practices open to all. It was a good marketing move since the term has the attention of the media and the public. Today, the term "PHILOTHERAPY" has been abandoned in favor of "PHILOSOPHY CONSULTATION" offered by "PHILOSOPHES CONSULTANTS".*
